NELSON MONGIOVI

Currently the Chief Marketing Officer for VISIT FLORIDA, Nelson Mongiovi has garnered three Emmy Awards, a National Gabriel and more than two dozen Associated Press and United Press International awards during his careers in broadcasting, communications and marketing.
