National Stop on Red Week
The goal of the **Stop Red Light Running Program** is to help educate the public on the dangers of red-light running. Red-light running is a serious intersection safety issue across the nation. The **Insurance institute for Highway Safety** (**IIHS**) reports that half of the people killed in red-light running crashes are not the signal violators. They are drivers and pedestrians hit by red-light runners.





In Florida: Children 5 years old or younger must be properly restrained in a federally approved, crash tested, child restraint device. Children 3 years old or younger must be in a separate carrier or a vehicle manufacturer's integrated child seat. For children 4 to 5 years old, a separate carrier, an integrated child seat or a child booster seat may be used. **Children 6 to 18 years old** must be properly belted at all times regardless of location within the vehicle. In addition, FDOT follows the **American Academy of Pediatrics** recommendations that **children age 12 and under** should ride properly buckled in the back seat.





